Alan Wayne Jones, BSc, PhD, DSc, was born in Wales, UK but has lived and worked in Sweden for the past 30 years. He is employed by the Swedish government and works at the Division of Forensic Genetics and Forensic Chemistry at the National Board of Forensic Medicine, which is located in the town of Linköping.

Besides his duties in forensic toxicology, Dr. Jones is also an adjunct professor in Experimental Alcohol Research at the University of Health Sciences, which is also located in Linköping. Since receiving his PhD degree in 1974, Dr. Jones has published extensively in the field of biomedical alcohol research and forensic toxicology including driving under the influence of alcohol and other drugs. In 1993 he was awarded a senior doctorate degree (DSc) by the University of Wales for his contributions to knowledge about alcohol and others psychoactive drugs.

Dr. Jones has lectured widely on forensic aspects of alcohol at home and abroad and has testified as an expert witness in USA, UK, Denmark, Norway, Ireland and hundreds of times in Sweden. An experienced peer-reviewer of scientific articles he serves on the editorial boards of six international journals devoted to biomedical alcohol research, forensic science, toxicology and legal medicine. He is author or coauthor of about 340 articles, reviews and book chapters, most of which have appeared in well-respected peer-reviewed scientific journals.

In recognition of his career-long contributions to research in the field of alcohol, drugs and traffic safety, Dr. Jones received the Widmark award from the International Council on Alcohol, Drugs and Traffic Safety (ICADTS) in 1997. His work in forensic toxicology was recognized in 2002 when he received the Rolla N. Harger award from the American Academy of Forensic Sciences (AAFS). Most recently (2004) Dr. Jones was the recipient of the Robert F. Borkestein award from the US National Safety Council, Committee on Alcohol and other Drugs.
